



Impact in Louisiana of the Affordable Care Act (ACA) (from OPE, U.S. Department of HHS)¹

Coverage Gains in Louisiana thanks to the ACA (2010-2015)

- 269,000 people gained coverage, including
 - 34,000 young people who gained coverage by staying on their parents' plan until 26 years of age
 - An overall 5.9% decline in the uninsured.
- As of January 17, 2017, 380,110 adults had enrolled in Medicaid as a result of Medicaid Expansion (<http://www.ldh.la.gov/HealthyLaDashboard/>)

Gains in Care, thanks to the ACA (2015)

- 387,587 Medicare Part B patients received free preventive services.

Consumer savings thanks to the ACA (Q1, 2016)

- For people with ACA Marketplace Plans
 - 170,806 people received subsidies averaging \$362/month
 - equals \$4344 in savings per person per year
- For people with Employer Group Plans
 - premium decrease from 7.3% annual growth rate in 2000-2010 to a 5.4% annual growth rate in 2010-2015
 - equals \$1600 annual savings per family in 2015
 - equals \$2400 annual savings per family in 2016

All these benefits lost to Louisiana families if the ACA is repealed.
