

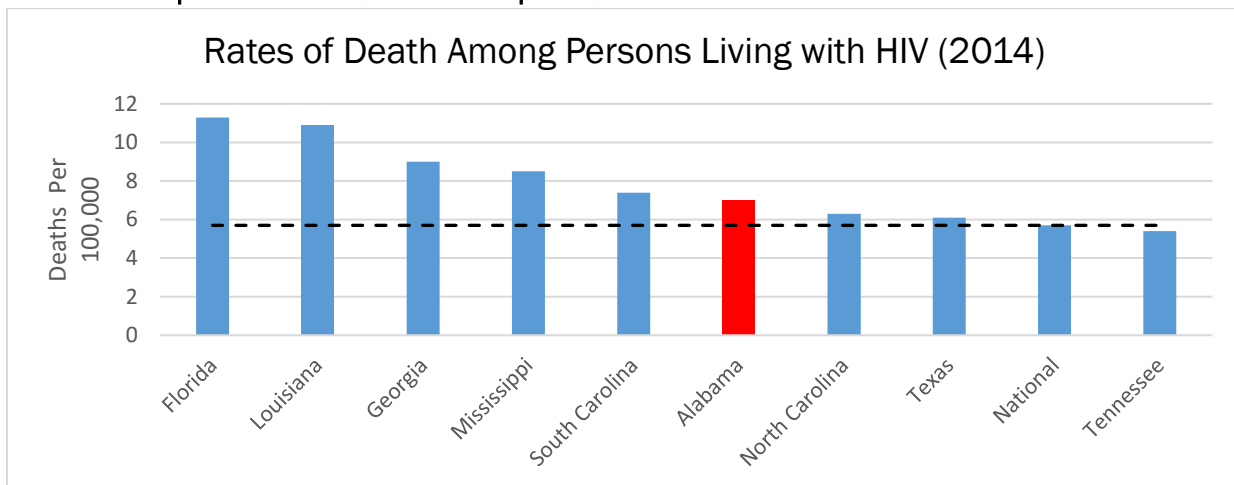


## HIV/AIDS in Alabama March 2017

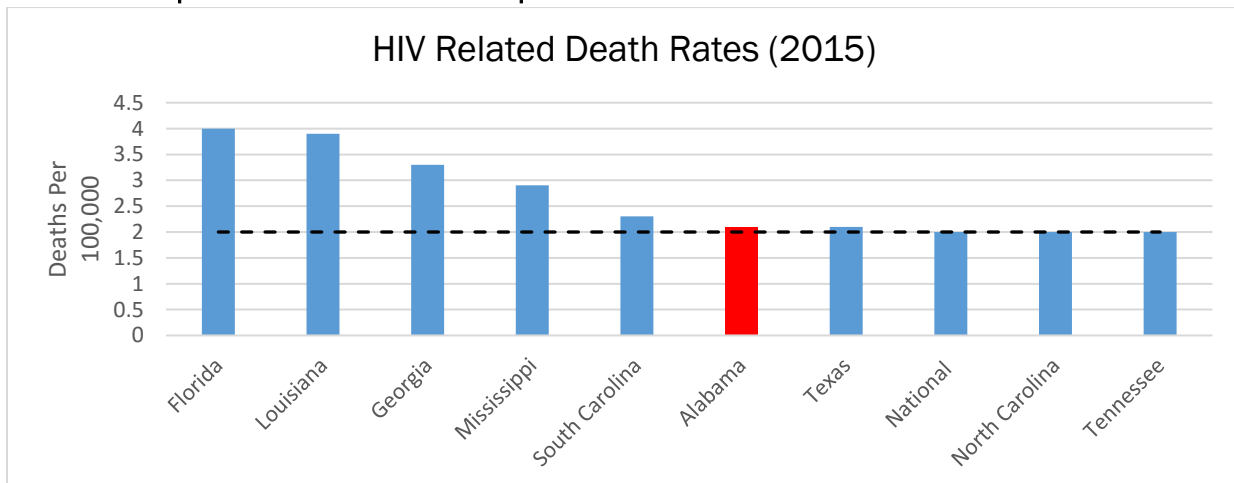
HIV in Alabama, by the most recent numbers.

- **11th**: in the nation for death rates among persons living with HIV in 2014.<sup>1</sup>
- **11th**: in the nation for HIV related death rates in 2015.<sup>2</sup>
