

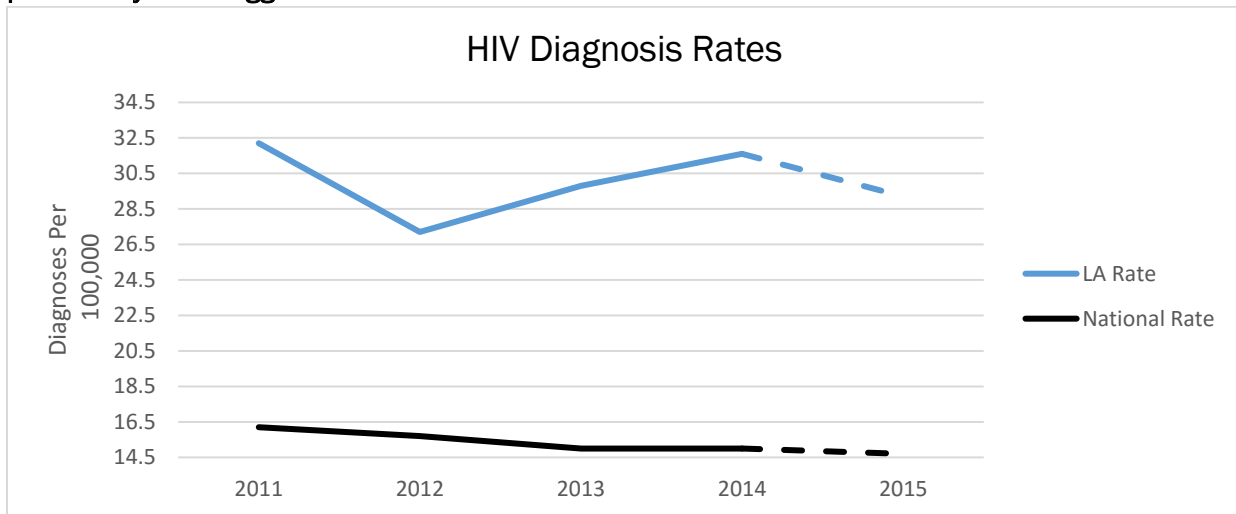


HIV/AIDS in Louisiana March 2017

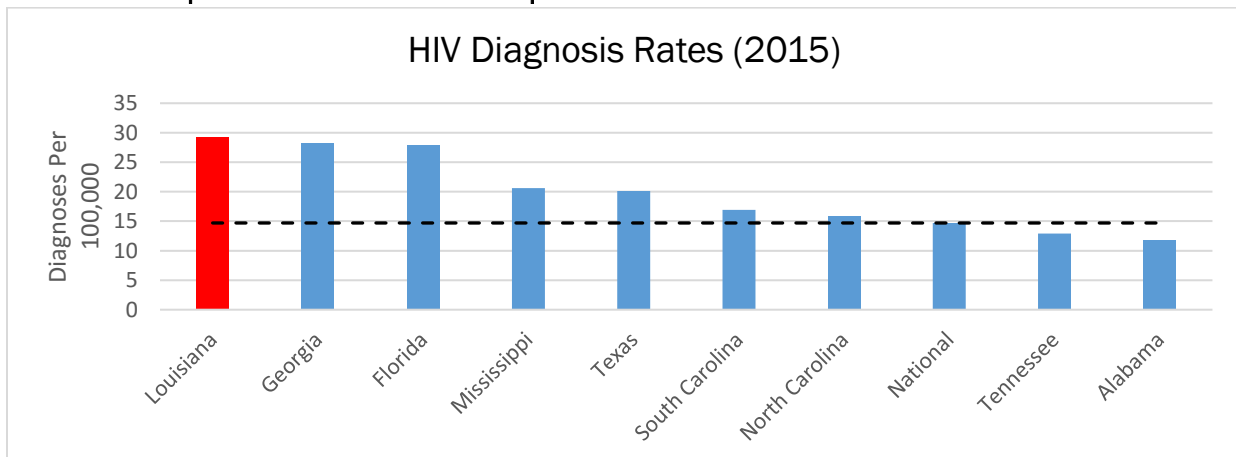
HIV in Louisiana, by the most recent numbers.¹

- **18,950**: the number of Louisianans living with diagnosed HIV/AIDS in 2014.
- **2nd**: in the nation for HIV diagnosis rates in 2015. In 2015 alone, 1,129 were newly diagnosed.

Louisiana's HIV diagnosis rate has consistently been higher than the national HIV diagnosis rate and preliminary data suggests that trend will continue.²
