

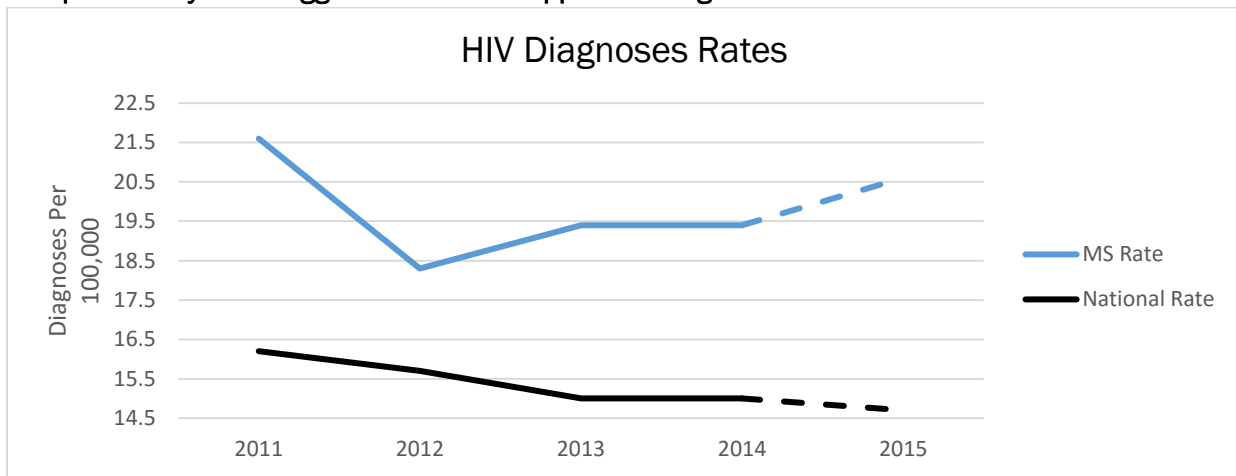


## HIV/AIDS in Mississippi March 2017

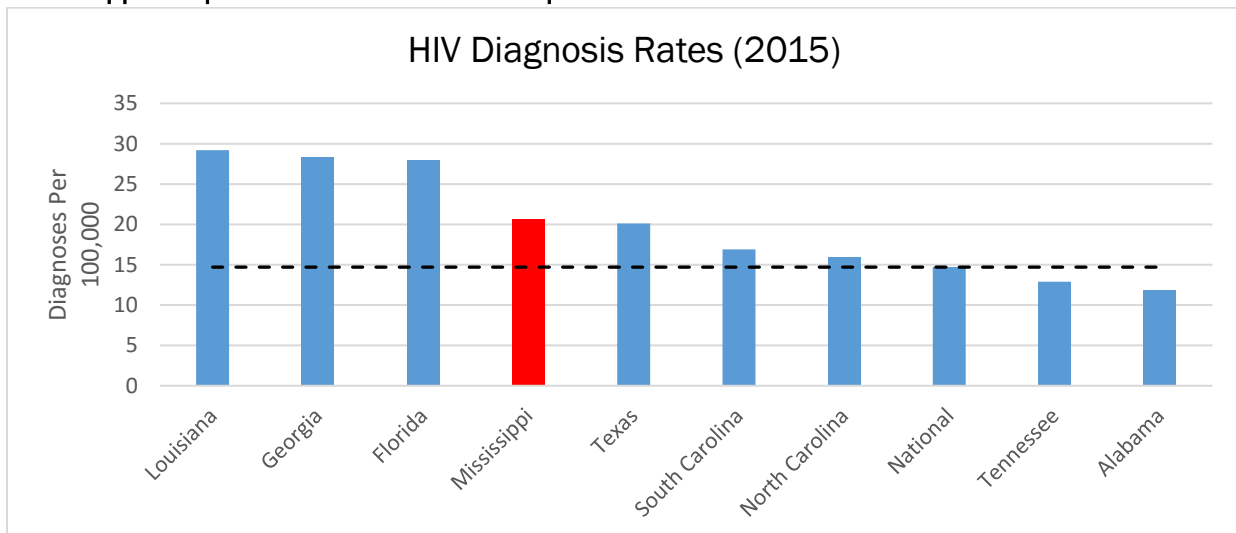
HIV in Mississippi, by the most recent numbers.<sup>1</sup>

- **8,983**: the number of Mississippians living with diagnosed HIV/AIDS in 2014.
- **6th**: in the nation for HIV diagnosis rates in 2015. In 2015 alone, 509 were newly diagnosed.

Mississippi's HIV diagnosis rate has consistently been higher than the national HIV diagnosis rate and preliminary data suggests that Mississippi's HIV diagnosis rate will continue to rise.<sup>2</sup>
