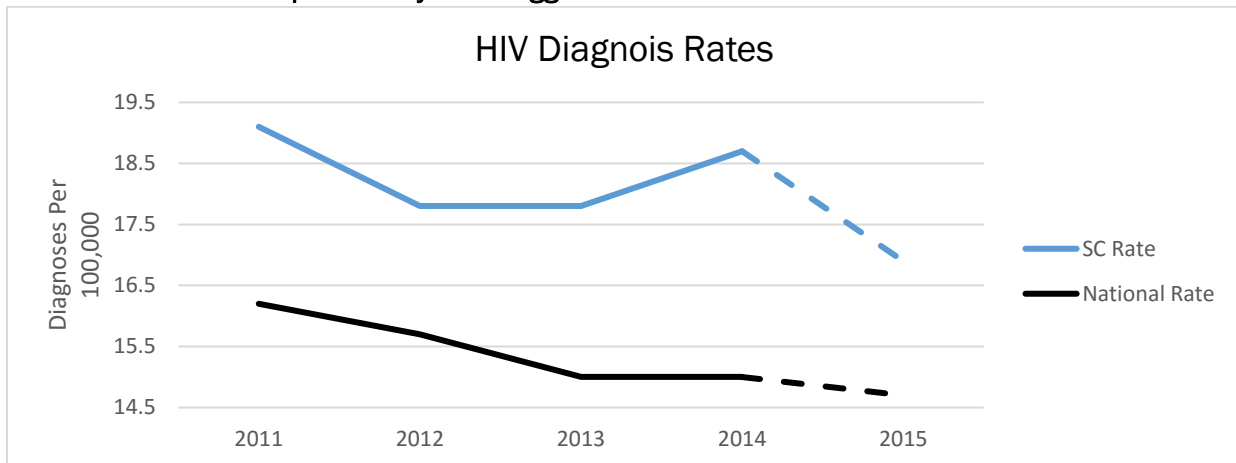


HIV/AIDS in South Carolina March 2017

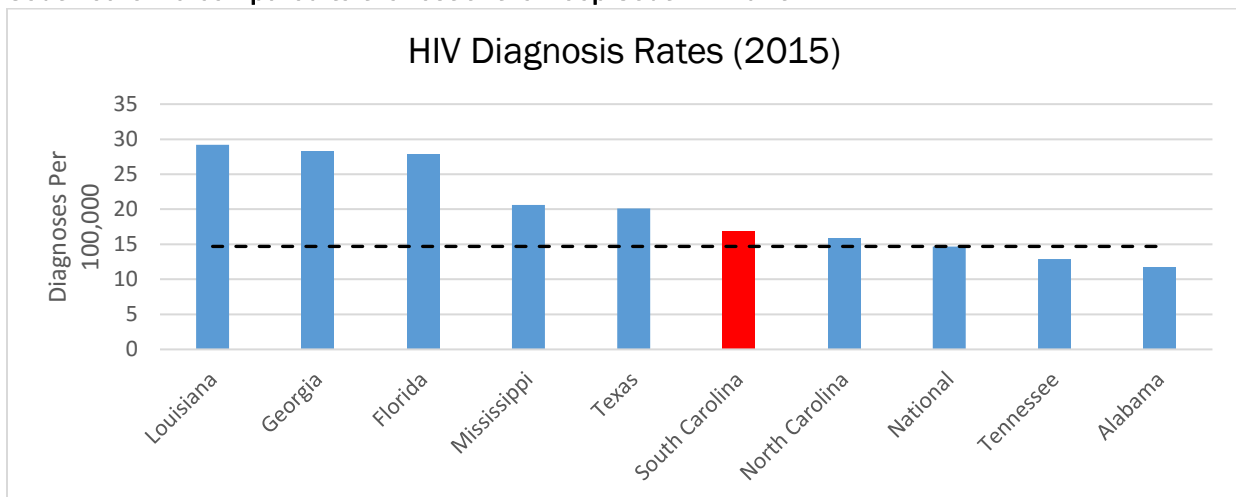
HIV in South Carolina, by the most recent numbers.¹

- **15,942**: the number of South Carolinians living with diagnosed HIV/AIDS in 2014.
- **10th**: in the nation for HIV diagnosis rates in 2015. In 2015 alone, 694 were newly diagnosed.

While South Carolina has made progress in reducing HIV diagnosis rates, South Carolina still lags behind the Nation and preliminary data suggests that trend will continue.²
