

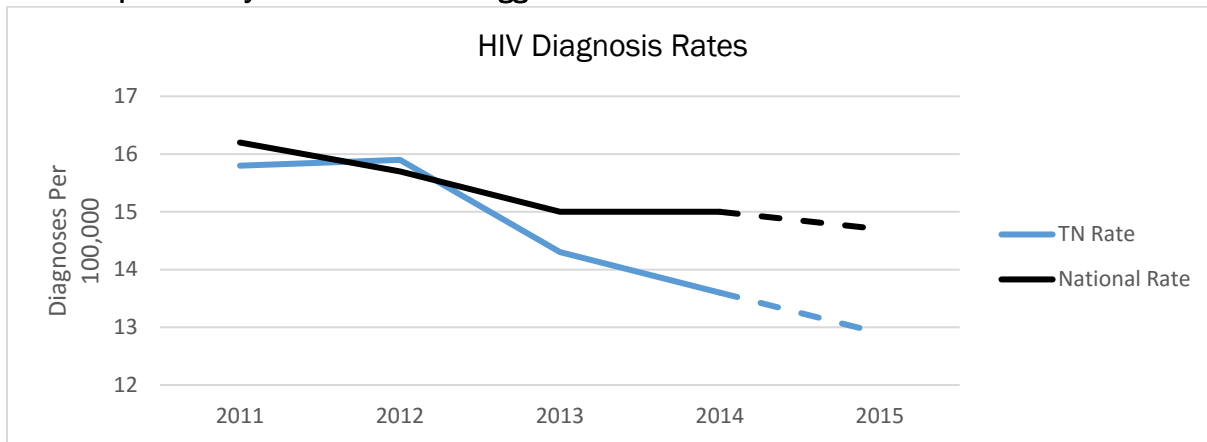


HIV/AIDS in Tennessee March 2017

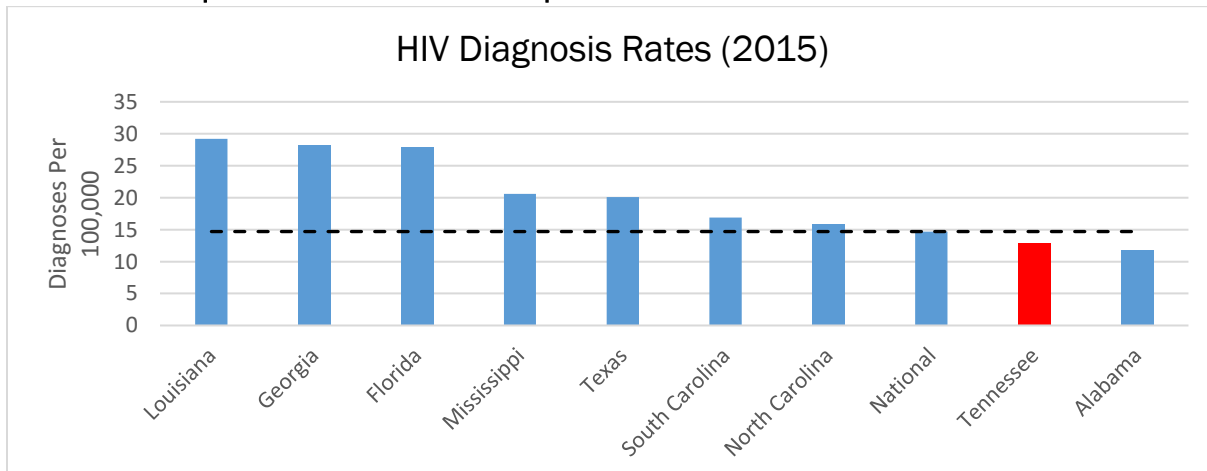
HIV in Tennessee, by the most recent numbers.¹

- **16,163**: the number of Tennesseans living with diagnosed HIV/AIDS in 2014.
- **17th**: in the nation for HIV diagnosis rates in 2015. In 2015 alone, 712 were newly diagnosed.

Since 2013, Tennessee has maintained a HIV diagnosis rate that is below the national HIV diagnosis rate and preliminary data from 2015 suggests that trend will continue.²
