

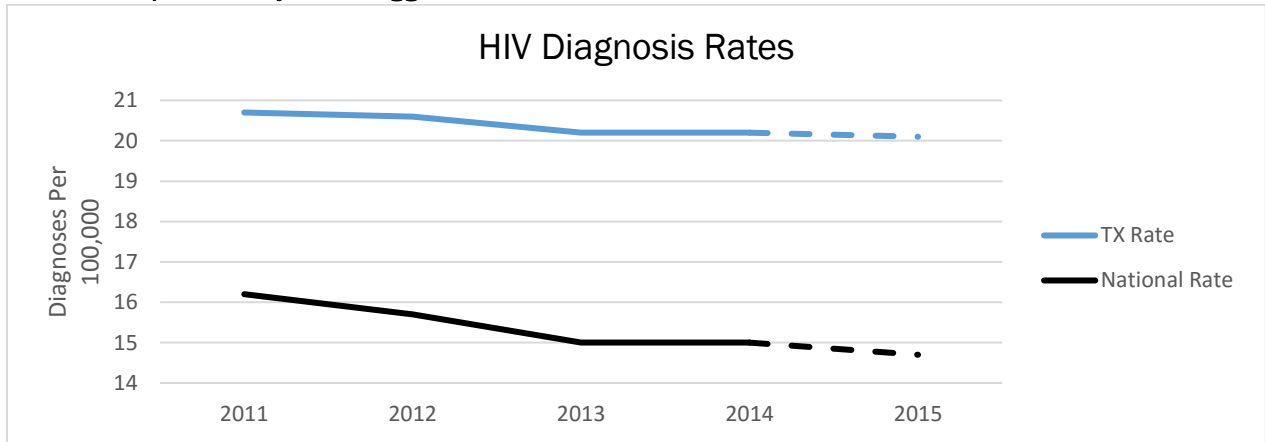


## HIV/AIDS in Texas March 2017

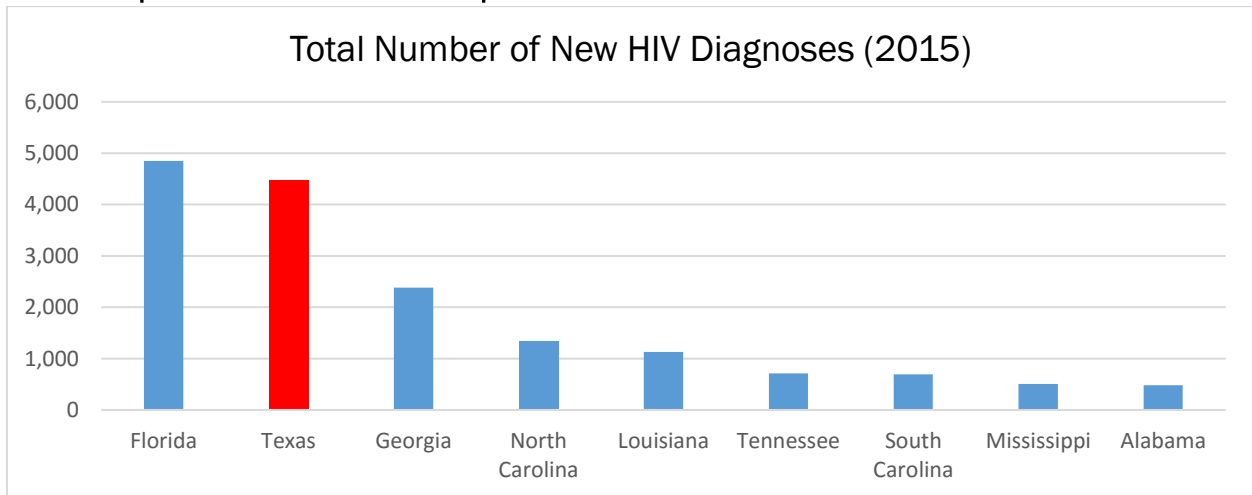
HIV in Texas, by the most recent numbers.<sup>1</sup>

- **77,896**: the number of Texans living with diagnosed HIV/AIDS in 2014.
- **3rd**: in the nation for the number of HIV diagnoses in 2015. In 2015 alone, 4,476 were newly diagnosed.

While Texas has made some progress in reducing HIV diagnosis rates, Texas still lags far behind the Nation and preliminary data suggests that trend will continue.<sup>2</sup>
